


CONFERENCE PROGRAM

Museums - Leading from the past to the future.

'Making farm women's stories more visible is not just about the past; it's essential to our future.' - Liza Dale-Hallett

Liza Dale-Hallett will share her experience as a museum curator and her work in uncovering farm women's stories for the Invisible Farmer Project. She will talk about the leading role of communities and museums in rewriting Australian rural history and giving greater visibility to women in agriculture.

Liza is the Lead Curator for the national Invisible Farmer Project - the largest ever study of Australian women on the land. This three year project (2017-2020) is funded by the Australian Research Council and involves a nation-wide partnership between rural communities, academics, government and cultural organisations.

Small museums across Australia have an important role in documenting our lives and preserving our stories. Liza will talk about a variety of ways museums are able to participate in this national project.

Bus Tour to Mitchell including:


